

- 1 Delicate and divine, the Agnes & Hoss Eucalyptus Signature Print pillow, \$173, features a printed silk front panel and faux suede back. Filled with 90 percent feather and 10 percent down inserts, the 19-inch by 19-inch pillow also comes in pink.
- 2 Named after the Hindi word for "glass and light," John Robshaw Textiles' Sheesha pillows, \$125 to \$275, illuminate any room with their mirror embellishments. The handwoven silk pillows come in a variety of colors, including ivory, sage and oatmeal.
- 3 For the traditional-style home, consider Michele Varian's Decadent Print Velvet Peridot pillow, \$202. It's printed silk velvet with velvet trim and a silk charmeuse reverse side.
- 4 Cuddle up with a furry friend in the form of Yves Delorme's Wilson pillow, \$135. Part of the Animal Accents collection, it's made from French cotton tapestry and comes in blue and red.
- 5 Designed by British textile designer Kirsty Anne Powell, the Oromono Coral pillow, \$142, adds three-dimensional punch to your home. Made from 100 percent English wool, it's available in five mix-and-match colors.
- 6 Caroline Cole's Natural Raspberry Floral pillow, \$250, adds a hint of color to a neutral palette. The cotton-and-rayon-blend pillow features an off-white 100 percent cotton brush fringe.
- 7 New to Kevin O'Brien Studio is the Paisley pillow, \$165. Shown in chocolate and peacock, the pillow is hand-silkscreened on unbleached linen and contains a down feather fill.
- 8 Hand-embroidered with a bold print, the Fauna Pillow by Judy Ross Textiles, \$190, has a canvas overlay backing and down feather insert. Shown in celadon, cream and fig, the pillow comes in a variety of color arrangements. ■
